- > SETU Sheltered Workshops for adults with learning and mental disabilities

**SETU Courses:** In 2025, we are proud that we have conducted our 9th SETU course, with a total of 14 people. This achievement brings the total number of graduates to 115, all of who have successfully completed their three-month basic training in the field of special needs.



**SETU Training Classes I & II:** In October 2025, students from Training Classes I and II completed their training and having they're graduation ceremony which was joyful and memorable event. And also, we are looking forward to receive new students in January 2026.

SETU Sheltered Workshop: We would like to extend our gratitude to everyone who made this great progress possible. In 2025, we are still happy to work with young people with intellectual disabilities in our sheltered workshop. Through this pioneering work, we aim to set an example of how adults with special needs can be supported professionally.
